FRAME-AMI Study (EHJ 2023; 44: 473–484)

Dr. JM Lee reported on a randomized trial comparing FFR-guided PCI versus Angio-guided PCI for residual lesions in AMI. The FLOWER-MI study had previously negated the utility of FFR guidance, leading to some confusion about how to determine PCI indications in such a situation. However, this study demonstrated that FFR guidance was significantly better not only for the primary endpoint of MACE but also for mortality, myocardial infarction, and revascularization. It would be valuable to hear Dr. Lee's direct opinion on the differences between this study and FLOWER-MI.
